2. Website Terms of Use

§1. General Provisions

This document sets out the rules for using the website of Mateusz Toruń — attorney-at-law, founder and creator of quality standards, available at www.mateusztorun.pl (hereinafter: the "Website"). The Website is informational, presentational and contact in nature. Using the Website constitutes acceptance of these rules.

§2. Nature of the Website

The Website serves to present the professional activities of the administrator, including his experience as an attorney-at-law, completed startup projects (Prevlly, LegalBee), ongoing initiatives (Centrum Homeoterapii, Standardy Homeopatii Klasycznej) and areas of specialisation: new technologies law, AI Act, GDPR, commercial and business law. The Website also enables contact via a contact form.

Content published on the Website is strictly informational and presentational in nature. The Website is not intended for concluding online agreements, maintaining user accounts or online sales, unless expressly stated otherwise.

Content published on the Website does not constitute legal, medical, health, therapeutic or any other individual professional advice. The materials are general in nature and cannot replace individual consultation with a relevant specialist.

§3. Rules of Use

The user undertakes to use the Website in a manner consistent with the law, good practices and the purpose of the Website.

The following are prohibited in particular:

- providing unlawful content,
- taking actions that may disrupt the operation of the Website,

- attempting to gain unauthorised access to the Website or its resources,
 - using content published on the Website in a manner contrary to its purpose, context or applicable law.

§4. Contact Form and Contact

§5. Copyright

Copying, distributing, modifying, adapting or further using such content without the consent of the administrator is prohibited, except as permitted by applicable law.

§6. Liability

The administrator makes every effort to ensure that content published on the Website is reliable, up to date and presented with due care. At the same time, the administrator does not guarantee the completeness or suitability of all materials for the individual needs of the user.

All materials and information published on the Website are used by the user solely at their own risk. The administrator shall not be liable for any decisions, actions, omissions, damages, consequences or effects resulting from the use, application, interpretation or reliance on the materials and information contained on the Website.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the administrator shall not be liable for:

3. Privacy Policy

§1. Data Controller

§2. Scope of Data

Through the Website, data voluntarily provided by the user may be processed, in particular: name and surname, e-mail address, the content of messages sent via the contact form, and any other data the user voluntarily provides in their message.

§3. Purposes of Processing

Personal data may be processed for the following purposes: handling messages sent via the contact form or e-mail, conducting correspondence, responding to questions or messages, protection against misuse and ensuring the security of the Website, and the potential establishment, pursuit or defence of claims.

§4. Legal Bases for Processing

Personal data are processed on the basis of:

- Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR — the legitimate interests of the administrator, consisting in conducting correspondence, handling contact, protecting the Website and defending against claims,
- Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR — where processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation,
- Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR — where the user has given consent, to the extent covered by that consent.

§5. Voluntary Nature of Data Provision

Providing data is voluntary, but may be necessary to send a message and receive a response.

§6. Recipients of Data

Data may be transferred to entities providing technical support for the operation of the Website, e-mail, hosting or the contact form — solely to the extent necessary for the operation of the Website and handling of contact.

§7. Retention Period

Data will be retained for the period necessary to handle the correspondence, and thereafter for the time required for archiving or defence against claims — no longer than necessary.

§8. Rights of the Data Subject

The data subject has the right to: access their data, rectify their data, erase their data, restrict processing, object to processing, withdraw consent at any time (where data are processed on the basis of consent), and lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

§9. Cookies

The Website uses cookies necessary for its proper functioning (including remembering the acceptance of the cookie banner). Where analytical or marketing cookies are also used on the Website, they are activated only after obtaining the user's consent.

§10. Amendments to the Privacy Policy

The administrator may update this privacy policy, in particular in the event of legal, organisational or technical changes.
